Something to Worry About!

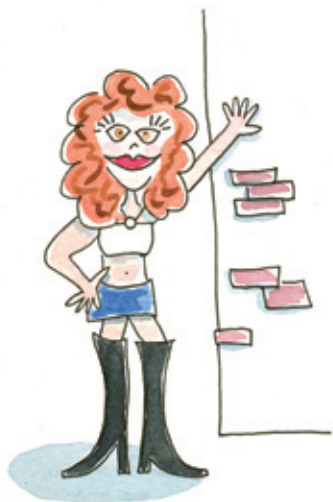
What if you think that you are thin, but you actually have a vision disorder that just makes you see yourself as thin when, in fact, you are totally plump? Think about it!
